Mid-Workshop Teaching Point in Kelley's Class

Teacher speaking to whole class:

"Alright, boys and girls. I need everyone to stop for just a minute and I need you to look at me."

Teacher speaking to student:

"Micah, I'm going to use your paper, ok?"

Teacher speaking to whole class:

"I want you to look at Micah's paper. This is the item that he chose to draw. What is this?"

Whole class speaking:

"A pinecone."

Teacher speaking to whole class:

"It is a pinecone. That is exactly right. And let me show you some of the details that Micah labeled in his pinecone. At the bottom of the pinecone he saw a little hole, so he drew the hole and he labeled it. That was a great detail. He also saw these little spikes and they're 'prick-y' and he labeled the spikes. So I want you to look at your pictures and I want you to look at your item and make sure that you're getting all of those small details. Alright, you may continue working."
