Student speaking:

Good job, good job. Micah, I want you boys and girls to listen to Micah, because we talked about something that he needs to work on. Micah what did we talk about that you needed to work on?"

Teacher speaking to whole class and individual student:

"Do you remember we read over you're sentences? And as Micah was rereading his sentences, he was like, 'That's not what I meant to say'. So, it's very important to go back and reread your sentences, ok?"
