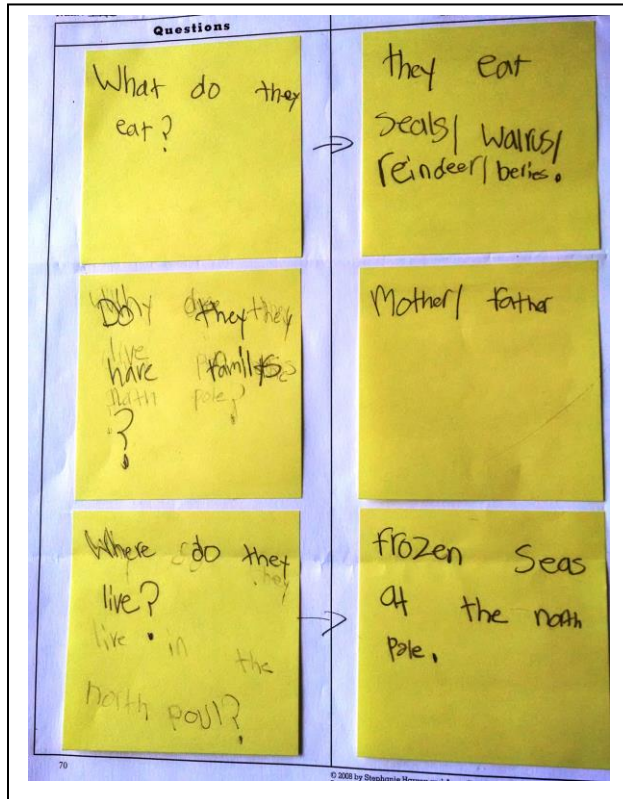

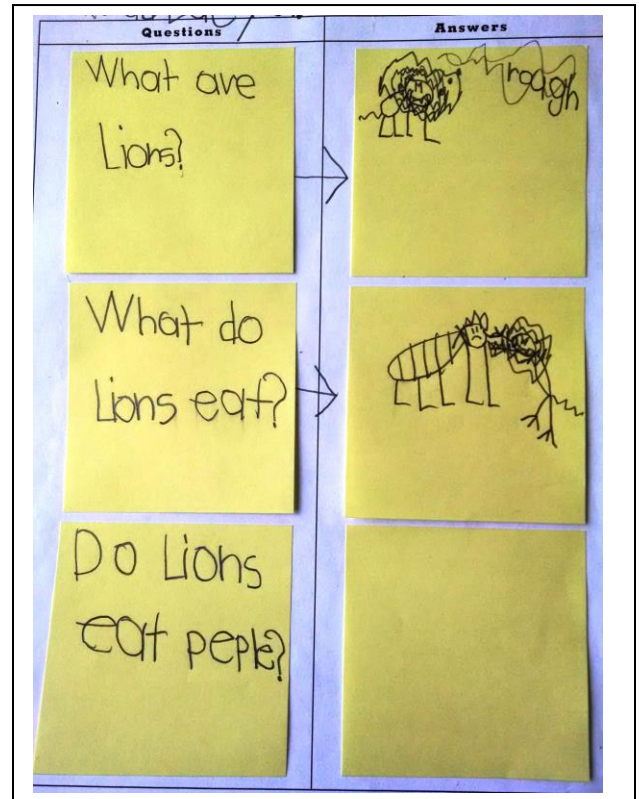
Student 3: The text read:

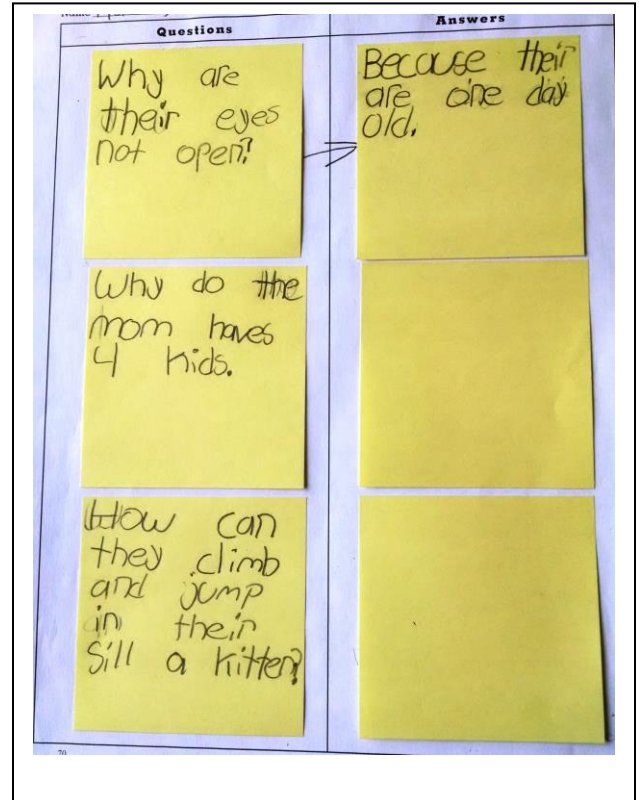
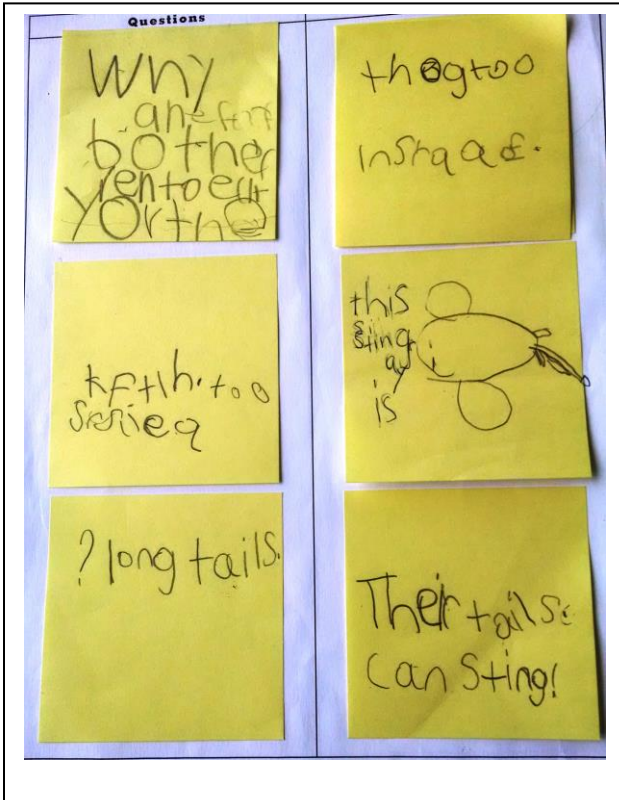


Student 5: The page of text headed "Food" read: "The polar bear's main food is seals./ (next page) It will also eat walrus, reindeer, and berries." The page headed "Homes" text read: "The polar lives on the land and frozen seas around the North Pole."
